1. Title of the Practice: **National Service Scheme**

2. Objectives of the Practice:

- To develop social approach in NSS Volunteers towards society.

3. The Context:

The motto of the NSS Unit is “Not Me But You”. The NSS Unit of the institute strive all its effort to fulfill the true meaning of motto by conducting Awareness, Upliftment and Development Programms to serve the society throughout the year. A Close study of the student’s inclination rebels that most of the students have an inherent tendency to serve the society by active involvement in the Nation Building Programs. In NSS camp student volunteers work with rural community and get sensitize about their problems. Apart from this, yoga training and observance of special days and NSS week programs were organized.

4. The Practice:

- N.S.S. Unit contributes to the the society by under taking initiatives and active participation in Happiness and Emotions School, Blood Donation Camp, Voter Awareness Program, “Swachh Bharat 2.0” Mission, “Organ Donation is Life Donation, Birds Nesting Program etc.
- Importance of Nutritional food is explained by providing Glucose Water Distribution to cleaning workers, traffic police and needy people by personally

interacting with them. Fruits were Distributed to old age home. Cloth Distribution to people living on footpaths.

- NSS Volunteers have also enthusiastically participated in Nation Building Program like "Kargil vijay Divas" and "Har Ghar Trianga" Program, Sending Rakhis to Indian Soldiers, Tiranga Utsav Padyatra, cleaned the statue of Mahatma Gandhi, Tribute to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel etc.
- NSS Volunteers donate their labour for village cleanliness and institutional premises. Awareness regarding cleanliness is created among villagers through Collaborative work, Morning rallies, Slogan and Signages, Street plays at N.S.S. CAMP.
- Important days and anniversaries of great men are celebrated like N..S.S Day, Veer vinod Kinariwala, Gandhi Jayanti, World Students Day, World Environment Day, Yoga Day.

5. Evidence of Success:

After joining the NSS Unit a noticeable change has been observed in the approach and perception towards life in student volunteers. They become more compassionate and integrated after knowing the life of the sufferers and develop sense of giving back to society.

1. Title of the Practice: National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.)

2. Objectives of the Practice:

As being the largest youth organization in the world, National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.) works with the foundational motto of 'Nation First & Character Must'. This unit aspires at developing character, commandership discipline, spirito of adventure and ideals of selfless service amongst the cadets. Simultaneously, the unit aims at generating leadership quality, trained and motivated youth who will serve the Nation in all the walks of iife. 3. The Context:

This Unit of Army wing NCC had been established in 1993. This unit is under I Gujarat Battalian. 
