Report on workshop on Glass Painting, Emboss Work, chemical and stoking flowers under CWDC In Association with Shreeji Handicraft 20/02/2017 TO 28/02/2017

Gujarat Commerce College organized workshop on glass painting, emboss Work, chemical and stocking flowers under CWDC in Association with Shreeji Foundation, Navrangpura, Ahmedabad from 21/02/2017 to 28/02/2017. Due to unavoidable situation sessions could not be held on 26th, 27th and 28th July, 2017. So instead of those days sessions could be carried out on 30th july, 1st and 2nd Aujust, 2017. This workshop was organized with the aim to make the female students of the college earn while learn. Nowadays days glass painting, stoking flowers and emboss work have become a popular feature and catching up as a hobby due to its awesome results and easy availability of glass painting equipment. At home (as a hobby), glass paintings can be as wall hangings, wine glasses painting, on windows, acrylic sheets, cups, mugs, tiles, mirrors etc. Emboss work help to give raised effect on selected areas. Stocking flowers are vintage DIY flowers. It gives new look to home. Total 48 girls participated in glass painting work shop. Trainer Khorasiya Jay, demonstrated the students the process of all these. Under his guidance students made, glass painting, embossed flowers, stocking flowers and chemical flowers. Per student 110 Rupees were paid by college and 110 Rupees were paid by students to the trainer of shreeji handicraft. All material was provided by Shreeji Foundation, Navrangpura, Ahmedabad. Daily girls were given work to do from home whatever they have learnt. At the end of workshop girls were given certificates for participation of workshop. The students who want to make their career can get benefit of loan and start their business on a small scale. So they can earn also. Even they can decorate their homes. The students were given to prepare at least 3 articles of glass painting, emoss flowers, stocking and chemical flowers during next 20 days. The exhibition was held on 22nd August, 2017 for the articles which were made by the students for sale in college. Thus students had earning from the workshop and if they continue themselves whatever they have learnt then they can earn in future also.

The Chairman of CWDC Prof. S. M. Bhadani and all the committee members made the entire workshop a grand success by encouraging the girls to start their own business.
