Vinod Kinariwala (9 August 1942) was a student of Gujarat College, Ahmedabad. On August 9, 1942, on the first day of the Quit India Movement launched by Mahatma Gandhi, he was shot dead by a British officer while hoisting the Indian flag in front of Gujarat College. The British officer asked him to put down the flag, but Kinariwala refused to do so. The officer then shot him dead. He was 18 years old at the time of his death.





Martyr Day of the student "Veer Vinod Kinariwala" who sacrificed his life for the sake of the country in the premises of Gujarat Commerce College. It is 10th of August. On the occasion of Veer Vinod Kinariwala's Martyr Day.
