Dr. R. L. Mojidra, Dr. M. B. Shah and Prof. J. C. Malhar arranged the industrial visit of Kalam Khush Handmade Paper Centre on 6th January 2024 Saturday. All coordinators and 20 students reach at the Centre at 9.15 am. Mr. Mohanbhai Desai, Manager of the Centre gave the information about the Centre. The Centre was established by Shri Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, former Deputy Prime Minister of India and Iron man of India.
