Notices shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been received if delivered in person, on the same day; if sent by facsimile (followed by mailing of the original), 24 hours after transmission; if sent by internationally recognized courier service, three (3) days after deposit with the courier; or if sent by registered mail, five (5) days after deposit into the mail system, in each case to the address set forth in the preamble to this MoU and as follows:

If to SPIPA: Attention: Dy. Director General

If to GCC: Attention: Principal, GCC

The Parties agree that any disputes arising under this MoU shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Courts at Ahmedabad and that this MoU shall be constructed according to and subject to the laws of India. The parties further stipulate that any dispute with regard to the interpretation of any term of this MoU, or with to any rights or liabilities of the parties arising out of this MoU, or in anyway connected with this MoU shall be referred to arbitration of a sole arbitrator to be appointed mutually by parties. The arbitration proceeding shall be held at Ahmedabad under Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. If any provision of this MoU is held unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, that provision shall be severed and shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining provisions.

Force Majeure

This MoU is subject to usual Force Majeure clause preventing the parties to discharge their obligations which includes incidents by fire, act of God, riot or other civil

commotion. Enemy action and/or other causes not within the control of parties and in such cases neither party is liable to pay compensation, claims and/or damages to any other party. National Conference On Gst : A Paradigm Shift In Indirect Taxation

State Sales Tax was levied on intra state sale of goods by State Governments in India. Significant reform was introduced from 2005 by Value Added Tax in place of State Sales Tax. VAT partially removed cascading effect of tax i.e. tax on tax and tax on goods again and again. Still cascading effect of tax was not completely removed. VAT is levied on value of goods plus Central Excise Duty which is levied by Central Government on manufacture of goods. Which is tax on a tax i.e. VAT is levied on Central Excise Duty therefore effect is of double taxation.

Currently Central Government can tax goods, only up to manufacturing or importing level where as State Government can tax goods, after manufacturing or importing level. At present only Central Government can tax Services and interstate sales. Indirect Taxes reform was initiated from 2005 by integrating all indirect taxes in Goods and Service Tax (GST) as one nation one tax levied by Central and State Governments to remove cascading effect completely. GST was to be implemented from 1st April 2010, but missed due to bring consensus among all the states. To levy GST Constitutional amendment required. 126th Amendment Bill passed by Parliament and upper house in 2016. It is decided GST is to be implemented from 1st April 2017.
