





Report on Report on 50 Meter Sprint





Report on Report on 80 Meter running - Female





Report on 1500 m and 5000 m Running Events





SHOT PUT GAME REPORT

On **21 March 2025**, Gujarat Commerce College held a well-organized shot put competition at the Football Ground on its Ahmedabad campus under bright, ideal conditions. Prof. J. C. Malhar and Dr. S. S. Solanki are game in-charge for male and female respectively. Twenty-four students—14 male and 10 female—participated, reflecting a healthy resurgence of field athletics on campus. In the women's category, **Rathod Urvashi** impressed everyone with a gold-winning throw of **5.65 m**, securing victory early with a controlled glide technique. **Rabari Mansi** earned silver at **5.33 m**, showing marked improvement across rounds, while **Gajera Tisa** claimed bronze with **5.05 m**, demonstrating her consistency. In the men's event, **Aakash Yadav** stood out with a powerful **9.08 m** throw—the only participant to cross the nine-meter mark—capturing gold decisively. **Patel Pratik** and **Diwakar Ankitkumar** earned silver and bronze with throws of **8.70 m** and **8.45 m**, respectively, rounding out a strong men's podium.

The event followed recommended shot-put conventions, including clearly marked safety zones, prohibition on spectators entering the throwing sector, and checking the circle for debris or irregularities before each attempt. Officials measured throws with steel tapes and enforced rules such as proper exit from the rear of the circle and no touching of the stop board's top. Volunteer marshals oversaw athlete check-in, maintained warm-up protocols, and removed implements promptly, ensuring smooth flow and safety throughout. A dedicated medical team was on standby, though no incidents occurred.

Medals were awarded to the top three in each category, and all athletes received participation certificates. Champions Urvashi and Yadav earned special recognition for their personal bests. Post-event feedback praised the balanced participation and noted that the event aligned well with best practices in field-event officiating and student-athlete safety. The successful competition will serve as a motivating springboard for enhanced training and future inclusion of related throwing disciplines.
