A. Observations

- **Focus on Employability:** The continuous, long-duration training provided by the Finishing School and UDISHA cell is commendable, ensuring sustained skill development.
- **National Recognition:** The participation of Cadet Sonara Sidhdhi in the RDC 2025 is a significant external achievement that elevates the college's profile.

B. Recommendations

- **Mandatory Attendance Reporting:** Several activities, particularly those organized by NSS, CWDC, and SRC, do not have participant numbers recorded (marked as N/A). It is strongly recommended that all organizing cells maintain mandatory records of attendance for future IQAC reporting to better assess impact and resource allocation.
- **Leveraging Cultural Success:** Future planning should allocate resources to sustain and expand large-scale events like the Gujarati Matrubhasha Divas to capitalize on high student interest.
- **Follow-up on Projects:** The status of the **Panch Prakalp Report 2024-25** should be tracked and documented in the subsequent quarterly report.
