INTRODUCTION OF THE EVENT:

Since the academic year 2016-17, the Government of Gujarat has launched an initiative aimed at improving students' life skills, employability skills and communication abilities through the Finishing School Programme. In line with the guidelines established by the Knowledge Consortium of Gujarat (KCG), Gujarat Commerce College, Ahmedabad, was given the opportunity to participate in the state's "Finishing School Project." Our college was selected as one of 20 higher education institutions to implement this pilot project.

The Finishing School project at Gujarat Commerce College, Ahmedabad, is a transformative initiative aimed at equipping students with essential skills that go beyond traditional academic knowledge. Through this program, students are trained in key areas such as life



skills, employability skills and functional and spoken English, ensuring they are well-prepared for the competitive job market. The finishing school seeks to bridge the skills gap between academic learning and the practical demands of the industry, particularly for fresh graduates. By providing targeted, short-term training, this project helps students gain industry-specific skills that enhance their employability, making them ready to thrive in global industries. The program plays a crucial role in shaping students into confident, skilled professionals ready to meet the dynamic challenges of today's workforce.

The Finishing School Programme consists of four modules, each comprising 20 hours of training: Module 1 and Module 2 focus on employability and life skills, while Module 3 and Module 4 emphasize functional English and communication skills. For the Finishing School, KCG has provided a list of approved experts to deliver the training sessions. Students have received guidance on topics such as grooming, etiquette, effective presentation, time management, CV writing, personal interviews and group discussions.

During the academic year 2025–26, Gujarat Commerce College organized the fourth batch of its 80-hour Finishing School training programme for B.Com. and M.Com. students. The programme was structured into four phases of 20 hours each, conducted from August 4–8, August 11–18, August 19–23, and August 25–30, 2025. A batch of 30 students participated in the training, which commenced on August 4, 2025, and concluded on August 30, 2025.

OBJECTIVES:

- The primary objective of this programme is to train the students in key areas such as life skills, employability skills and functional and spoken English, ensuring they are well-prepared for the competitive job market.
- To bridge the skills gap between academic learning and the practical demands of the industry, particularly for fresh graduates.
- To play a crucial role in shaping students into confident, skilled professionals ready to meet the dynamic challenges of today's workforce.
- To build confidence, critical thinking, leadership, and interpersonal abilities essential for personal and career growth.
- To equip students with interview techniques, presentation skills, workplace etiquette, and team collaboration practices.



- To strengthen **self-awareness, positive attitude and emotional intelligence**, enabling students to adapt to diverse environments.
- To provide **practical training** that aligns with the expectations of employers and real-world professional scenarios.

- The students are trained in key areas such as life skills, employability skills and functional and spoken English, ensuring they are well-prepared for the competitive job market.
- By providing targeted, short-term training, this programme helps students gain industry-specific skills that enhance their employability, making them ready to thrive in global industries.
- Students can communicate confidently and effectively in English (both verbal and written).
- Demonstrate improved presentation, group discussion and public speaking skills.
- Exhibit enhanced problem-solving, decision-making and time management abilities.
- Apply professional etiquette and workplace ethics in interviews and job roles.
- Show increased self-confidence, adaptability and career preparedness for higher studies or employment.

FEEDBACK

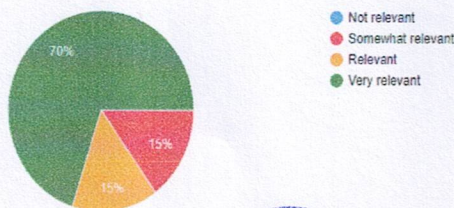
Based on the responses collected for the Finishing School programme (English Skills & Life Skills), the overall feedback reflects a high level of satisfaction and positive impact among participants.

The Life Skills programme received an overall satisfaction score of 4.9 out of 5 with the content’s **relevance, engagement and usefulness**. Students appreciated the programme’s focus on communication skills, professional etiquette and personal development, describing it as highly relevant to both academic growth and future career opportunities. Almost all respondents indicated that they would recommend the programme to their peers, demonstrating its perceived value and effectiveness.

Would you recommend this program to your peers?

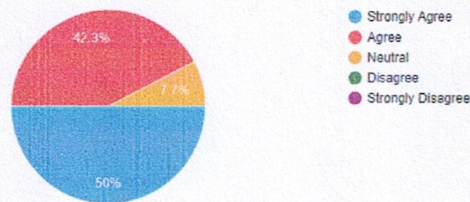


How relevant was the content of the program to your academic and professional development?

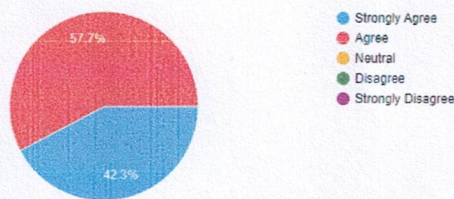


Similarly, The English Skills programme received an overall satisfaction score of 4.5 out of 5. Participants consistently praised the **structure, methodology and practical activities**. Most students agreed or strongly agreed that the sessions were well-structured, interactive and effectively organized, with activities, discussions and practical exercises that enhanced their understanding. Many participants highlighted improved grammar, vocabulary, presentation and writing skills as key takeaways and expressed confidence in applying these skills in their academic and professional lives. Suggestions were minimal, with a few requesting more debates and group discussions to further build confidence.

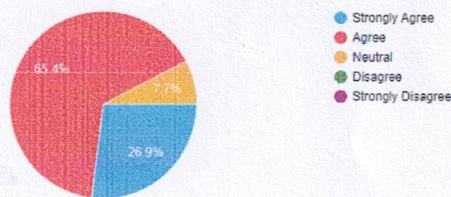
The programme was well-structured and systematically organized.




The methodology adopted (lectures, discussions, activities) facilitated learning.




